RULES AND PROCEDURES

The problems will test the contestant's skills and knowledge of the following CAD issues:

- Layers
- Geometry Creation
- Modifying Geometry
- Layouts
- Annotations

The drawing requirements may include, but are not limited to, the above areas. Necessary problem background information, drawing requirements and reference materials will be provided.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judging will be done by qualified drafting professionals currently working in the industry and Fresno City College CADD students.

Drawings will be returned to the instructors after the competition. The grading criteria is printed at the bottom of the problem so each contestant is aware of exactly what the judges will be looking for during judging, (judges are unable to write comments on entries due to time constraints).
