SCOPE OF CONTEST

Following all school/program safety guidelines and procedures, create a 60-second video. Find a creative and original (not a re-creation) way to showcase a movie trailer based on a Documentary of the Central Valley. Video must be uploaded as an unrestricted link to YouTube.

NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

The competition is a team (up to four members), limited to 30 entries. *Fresno ROP reserves the right to modify enrollment due to limited spaces available.*

RULES AND PROCEDURES

- Following all school/program safety guidelines and procedures, create a 60-second video. Find a creative and original (not a re-creation) way to showcase a movie trailer based on a Documentary of the Central Valley. Your finished 60-second video must include a spoken *and* visual tag-line that promotes your movie. This can be in the form of a voiceover, or a line of dialogue spoken by an actor.
- 2. Talent and voiceovers within entry are not restricted to students only.
- 3. Copyrighted music not allowed.
- Export settings for Premiere Pro: Format – H.264; Bitrate – VBR, 2 pass; Target Bitrate (Mbps) - 14; Render at Maximum Depth; Use Maximum Render Quality
- 5. All entries must include "Presentation Notes" with a link to the unrestricted video on YouTube (see page 2). The notes must also describe the intent of the entry and have a brief description of the method/processes used in creating the video.
- All entries, with accompanying presentation notes and student/school information, must be in the Fresno ROP office by March 3, 2025 at 4:00pm. You can email the entry to sgeorge@fcoe.org or drop off at: Fresno ROP
