Team Size: 4 contestants (students will be placed into 4 groups)

#1 Corsage: 30 minutes

- Materials provided: fresh flowers and greenery, wristlet
- Materials contestants need to bring: floral shears, floral tape, ribbon, floral glue
- Students will create a corsage that would be appropriate for wearing to a prom

#2 Written Test: 30 minutes

- Materials provided: scantron and typed test questions
- Materials contestants need to bring: #2 pencil
- Students will take a multiple choice 25 question exam

#3 Arrangement Construction: 30 minutes

- Materials provided: vase/floral foam/ container, water, fresh flowers and greenery
- Materials contestants need to bring: floral shears
- Students will be given a set of flowers and greenery to make a design style of their choice. They will be scored on the appropriateness of usage of the materials and their creativity of the design.

#4 Flower Identification: 15 minutes

- Materials provided: scantron, floral tools for identification and number cards
- Materials contestants need to bring: #2 pencil
- Students will identify the correct name of the 25 flowers based off of the identification list from the CATA Curricular code.



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#5 Potted Plant Identification: 15 minutes

- Materials provided: scantron, floral tools for identification and number cards
- Materials contestants need to bring: #2 pencil
- Students will identify the correct name of the 25 potted plants based off of the identification list from the CATA Curricular code.

#6 Floral Tool Identification: 15 minutes

- Materials provided: scantron, floral tools for identification and number cards
- Materials contestants need to bring: #2 pencil
- Students will identify the correct name of the 25 floral tools based off of the identification list from the CATA Curricular code.
